



Livery Costs and Membership

Annual membership fees are known as “Quarterage”

Quarterage is invoiced in August for payment on, or before 1st October, latest)

Freemen (New Members)

Your first Quarterage payment will be pro-rated depending on what time of year you join. After that your Quarterage invoice will be sent to you every August.

Progressing through the Livery

New members (Freemen) can be invited to progress to the enhanced status of Liveryman. The invitation is usually made when a Freeman has demonstrated support for the Company through regular attendance at events and activities, including support of our charitable activities or by volunteering for our various Committees.

Livery status requires members to first be granted the Freedom of the City of London through the Chamberlain’s Court, allowing attendance of the Corporation’s Common Hall and Election of the Lord Mayor and Sheriffs at Guildhall. Liverymen are also eligible to be put forward for the office of WCI Court Assistant.

Freedom of the City	£150	Payable direct to Chamberlain’s Court

Court Assistant, Warden and Master

Liverymen who seek election to Court must be on one of the Livery’s Committees and be active supporters of WCI events and charitable activities. The Appointments Committee meets quarterly to review proposals and make recommendations at the July Election Court Meeting.

Payment for Events

All events require payment at the time of booking. Should we need to invoice, payment terms are 14 days from the booking date and are due one week before the date of the event. We reserve the right to cancel any unpaid places to offer to other members. Please note that, because of the need to confirm catering requirements in advance, refunds for WCI events will only be given if the cancellation is received more than one week before the event.

Charitable Contributions and Gift Aid

Philanthropy and volunteering are at the heart of our mission. If you are a taxpayer, you will be invited to sign a Gift Aid form, allowing the Trust to reclaim the tax on any payments you make. This boosts the Company's income available for charitable causes by 25p in every £1 at no extra cost to you.

If you are a higher-rate taxpayer, you can reclaim, from HMRC, the difference between the standard rate and any higher-rate tax that you may pay. You also have the option of paying over this reclaim to the charity (Registered Number 1000562).
