How to apply for membership

We have two categories of membership: Freemen and Liverymen. To be admitted to the Company as a Freeman (the first stage) you will need to be proposed and seconded by two members of the Livery, one of whom should also be a Court Assistant (if neither is a Court Assistant, the nomination should also be endorsed by a Court Assistant). As supporting Liverymen, your Proposer, Seconder and Court Assistant will be asked to provide details about you. If you do not have a proposer or seconder please contact assistant@wci.org.uk for alternative ways of applying.

Your qualifications

All new applicants are expected to be professionally qualified in insurance and/or have the necessary experience from having held senior management, or academic positions where insurance has played a prominent part, e.g. a lawyer or accountant.

Admitting new members

A Membership Committee meets regularly to consider nominations and make recommendations for membership. With numbers limited by its constitution, the Company aims to maintain a balanced membership in terms of age and the various groups engaged in the Lloyd's or company markets. The Company retains absolute discretion with regard to the acceptance or refusal of an application for membership.
